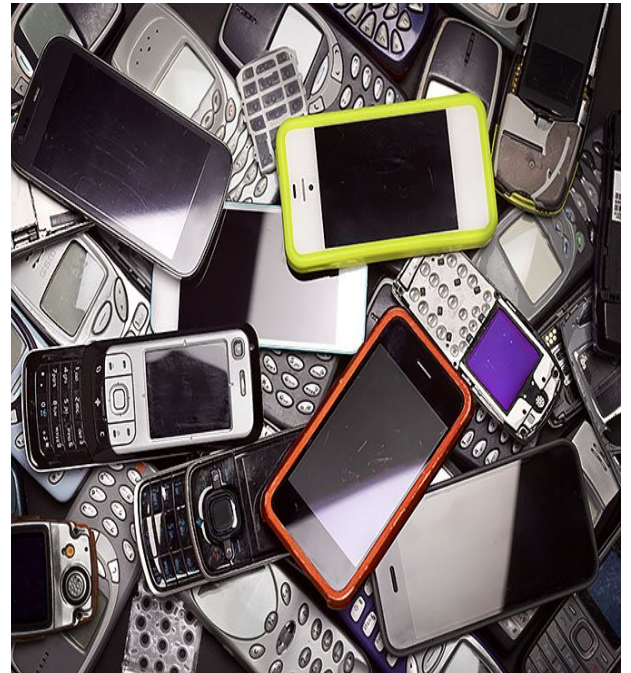
But their spirits are not dampened, and Bible Study continues through the book of Exodus – Chapter 1. Last month, Mervis travelled to a district
