Prayer of Commitment

If anyone comes to Me, and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple.

Luke 14:27

Life is about relationships, and relationships are about commitment. The deepest commitment that anyone can make to another are these words: "I give you my life." The *Prayer of Commitment* embodies the meaning of that statement. Marriage vows are believed by most to be the important and binding of all commitments, and yet almost 50% of marriages in America end in divorce or separation. How can that be?

The Apostle Paul uses the example of marriage between a man and woman to describe the relationship of Christ to His Church. Both are permanent unions in which two become one; therefore, both require TOTAL commitment. With regard to marriage, a simple exchange of vows seals the deal. Wow, that's heavy! Should it not follow then that "marriage" to Christ include a vow, like a *Prayer of Commitment*?
